In any period of 24 hours a detainee must be allowed a continuous period of at least 8 hours for rest, free from questioning, travel or any interruption in connection with the investigation concerned. This period should normally be at night or other appropriate time which takes account of when the detainee last slept or rested.

Rest period will run from: 23:00 - 07:00

When the DP is awake they are to be informed of this review and reminded of their 'continuing rights' under code C -

- 1) The right to consult privately with a solicitor and the provision of free legal advice (either in person or over the telephone), the right to have someone informed of their arrest (unless incommunicado), and the right to consult the Codes of Practice.
- 2) To remind them that should they have any concerns / feel unwell then to please speak with a member of the custody team who will assist.
- 3) Any representations they wish to make with regards to their detention or treatment whilst in custody are to be recorded and brought to the attention of the review officer.
- 4) That staff are here to help, and regarding HCP and the provisions of fresh air via the yard when available.
- 5) Female detainees are to be reminded of female staff on duty and female hygiene products if needed.
